SUMMARY OF CHANGES IN CHAPTER 120 1989 LEGISLATIVE SESSION

One law was enacted during the 1989 Legislative Session making changes to Chapter 120, Florida Statutes: Chapter 89-147, Laws of Florida.

The following summary of change was prepared by the Senate Natural Resources and Conservation Committee.

Chapter 89-147, Laws of Florida

This chapter amends subsection 120.52(16)(d), Florida Statutes, by exempting from the definition of a rule any agency action having the effect of altering the established annual harvest limits for saltwater fishing if the procedure from altering such harvest limits is set out by rule of the Marine Fisheries Commission, provided such action is adequately noticed by publication or broadcast in the electronic media. [Because the Marine Fisheries Commission expects to close some commercial fisheries upon attainment of specified annual quotas, this legislation will permit the Commission to alter quotas as needed without lengthy rulemaking pursuant to Chapter 120, Florida Statutes.]
